2017 BURSARY & SCHOLARSHIP

One \$750.00 bursary for either full time or part-time student. One \$750.00 scholarship for either full time or part-time student.

Qualifications:

- Retail Regulatory members or dependents.
- Enrolled in a recognized post-secondary school or college in Canada.
- Three or more courses per semester constitutes full-time studies.
- Enrollment in any credit course in the University of Saskatchewan, University of Regina, Saskatchewan Polytechnic, Saskatchewan Regional Colleges, Northland College, Gabriel Dumont Institute or Labour College of Canada.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE

- <u>All</u> qualified members or dependents are encouraged to apply. **Priority will be given to first time applicants.**
- The sector will only issue one award (Bursary / Scholarship) per applicant per year.

Persons eligible for the Retail Regulatory award must be:

- Members in good standing of SGEU who have held membership in the union for at least one year.
- Dependents of current, retired or deceased.SGEU members
- Students attending a recognized university, community college or other postsecondary institution; the Labour College of Canada; other institution or courses considered appropriate.
- Full time students may apply prior to their academic year.
- Part time students may apply for courses taken during the year 2017 or the first semester of 2018.

SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS

The awarding of bursaries/scholarships will be based on;

- Total financial status.
- Program of studies.
- Submission of an essay of approximately 500 words as specified under Essay Guidelines" The essay must be submitted with a candidate's application form.
- Bursary/Scholarships winners will be selected by the Sector Education Sub-Committee at a September/October meeting.
- Announcement of the successful applicant will occur in September/October

Essay Guidelines:

- The essay of approximately 500 words will need to include a report on the interviews with at least three SGEU members on the benefits of union membership, and what belonging to a union means to them. What benefit unions play in Social Justice and their role in the community.
- The essay needs to involve an analysis or reflection of knowledge gained through interviews and research.
- The selection committee will look for evidence that you've done some work and learned from the exercise. The understanding you've conveyed will outweigh the technical aspect of the essay. If you use published resources or internet, remember to note these in your bibliography.

AWARDING OF BURSARY OR SCHOLARSHIP

- The bursary and scholarship may be paid directly to the education institute. The funds will be credited to the account of the recipient at the institution.
- The successful applicant will have to supply proof of registration to the contact person listed below within 30 days of being notified that they were the successful applicant.
- After 30 days the award will be issued to the next qualified applicant. The first applicant will then be determined unqualified.
