EDUCATION SECTOR SCHOLARSHIPS

The Education Sector offers four \$1,000.00 scholarships each year. These scholarships are open to Education Sector members or Education Sector member dependent applicants in any post-secondary program at any approved public institution in Saskatchewan.

Applicants whose field of study is not available or is over subscribed in Saskatchewan may be considered for the scholarship.

One scholarship is for **SGEU members in good standing that belong to the Education Sector.**

Three scholarships are for **dependents of SGEU members** in good standing that belong to the Education Sector. Of these three, one of these scholarships is for a dependent graduating grade 12 and entering post secondary studies, one is for a dependent continuing in Vocational and Technical Post Secondary studies, and the last scholarship is for a dependent continuing in University Post Secondary studies.

A dependent is defined as someone who:

- has never been married or lived common-law
- does not have any children
- is 25 years of age or under
- has not been out of the secondary school system for four years or more
- has not been in the workforce for two periods of 12 consecutive months since leaving secondary school

If any of the scholarships are unused, it may be allocated to the other group.

APPLICATION FORMS AND SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS MUST BE POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN AUGUST 31.

PLEASE ENCLOSE TRANSCRIPTS OF FINAL MARKS FOR THE LAST YEAR OF STUDY.
