Re: July 7, 2011 Correspondence

The Saskatchewan Government and General Employees' Union Bargaining Committee (SGEU Local 2151) has reviewed your letter. In it you state Saskatchewan Crop Insurance Corporation (SCIC's) disapproval of the neutral stance that the bargaining committee is taking while preparing the membership for a ratification vote on the recent Memorandum of Agreement (MOA).

Since signing the MOA on June 24th, the SCIC Bargaining Committee has forwarded the MOA to Local 2151's principals for ratification. Approval was granted by the Crown Sector Committee, then forwarded to and approved by SGEU's Administrative Committee. Local 2151 requested and was given the required approval from these internal SGEU Committees for ratification.

Local 2151 finds it discouraging that there has been outside interference throughout this round of negotiations and would prefer that those external to the process discontinue their interference in the way in which the Bargaining Committee is communicating with it's membership.

We also find it unfortunate that SCIC would feel that an application before the Labour Relations Board would be beneficial to either party. Please inform us if you choose to move in that direction.
