Your bargaining committee is preparing for the upcoming round of negotiations with the employer and is requesting as much participation as possible from the members. It is your right and privilege under the SGEU constitution and within the bargaining unit's guidelines to participate in the proposals gathering process.

We ask that you review the enclosed proposal form and submit it to your shop steward before February 1, 2010. Late or emergency proposals will be given consideration at the proposals conference which is tentatively being scheduled for early March.

Article 4 of the SCIC Bargaining guidelines states that:

- a) The Bargaining Committee will call for contract proposals. All SGEU members of the local in good standing shall have a right to submit proposals and contract revisions.
- b) The Bargaining Committee shall hold a proposals conference of the stewards and all elected union committee representatives of the local. Proposals shall be ratified by a majority vote of those in attendance.

Stewards and elected committee members will be notified of the times and date of the proposals conference well in advance. We urge their attendance.
