The SLGA Negotiating Committee has been meeting with management to discuss problems regarding the use of part-time workers. Unfortunately, we have been unable to resolve our differences. SGEU has been informed that management plans to implement a three month pilot project in the warehouse and selected stores and begin staffing those facilities using the hours previously available to part-time workers to create temporary full-time positions. Management has indicated they will follow the staffing process as outlined in the collective agreement.

Because our concerns regarding filling shifts with part-time workers have not been resolved, the Negotiating Committee plans to bring the issue forward for a full discussion with the membership during the next round of bargaining, beginning in 2007.

The Negotiating Committee requests your feedback on this pilot project, now and during its implementation. All members are encouraged to discuss any questions, concerns and recommendations with their steward, chief steward or Negotiating Committee members.
