



To be eligible you must:

- · Be registered as a student in a Saskatchewan unionized educational institution, and
- Be a member in good standing of SGEU, or
- Be the spouse of a member in good standing of SGEU, or
- Be the dependent of a current member in good standing of SGEU

All of the following documents must be included with your application:

- · Copy of your transcript (grades) from the last year of your education, and
- Copy of the Letter of Acceptance or Confirmation of Enrollment by the Sask. unionized educational institution for the current school year, and
- Proof of Aboriginal ancestry (for Metis individuals that do not have a card, a letter from a local president or some other form of proof will be considered), and
- Proof of membership in SGEU (if a spouse or dependent of a member, then proof of their membership in SGEU), and
- An updated resume
- Essay (200-500 words) describing yourself; detailing your involvement in the community and the Union (if applicable) and the life goals you wish to achieve through your education
