ALLAN KEHLER: is a highly sought-after speaker who aims to empower his audience to live opposed to exist. Allan spent a significant amount of his life persevering through mental health issues and addictions. On the outside, people saw the man who was president of his school, athlete of the year and national scholarship winner. However, on the inside was a man who was in pain. A university professor saw beneath the mask and changed Allan's life through a simple process. Allan shares this approach in his message and reassures his audience that nobody needs to be fixed. Rather, the value of being seen and heard is immeasurable.

His first book *Stepping Out from the Shadows: A Guide to Understanding & Healing from Addictions* has been incorporated into college curricula. Allan's writing has been published in countless national magazines and he has also been featured on several television and radio programs.
